## **A Louis XV Corne Verte Bracket Clock**

The dial signed 'Jolin a Orleans', the movement signed conformingly.

A Fine Louis XV Gilt-Bronze Mounted Corne Verte Bracket Clock, the movement by *Louis Jolin*, the circular enamel set Roman dial signed '*Jolin a Orleans*', the movement signed conformingly.

The clock has an arched shaped waisted case surmounted by a foliate finial on a spreading hood, the case is mounted with rockwork, 'C' scrolls and foliage on scrolling foliage wrapped feet, the shaped tapering bracket inlaid with an engraved brass cartouche and terminating in a pierced foliate boss.

### **Artist description:**

Louis Jolin was a maître horloger in Orleans, France, from 1741 until his death in 1781.
