A Large Louis XVI Style Gilt-Bronze Cylindrical Four-Light Lantern.

This large lantern is of cylindrical form with four ribbed uprights supporting a frame with beaded swags and ribbons and surmounted by ostrich-plume finials.

Originally fitted for gas the lantern has now been wired for electricity.
