Artist description:

Jollet Et Cie produced 'bronzes d'art et d'ameublement' from premises at 17, Tournelles, Paris. Monsieur Jollet, 'fabricant-éditeur', joined from the Colin foundry in 1906/07 and signed his work "Jollet et Cie". From 1911, M. Jollet established an independent foundry which operated until his death in 1923 and the company was dissolved of June that year.
